Farm Advice

Mark it, Remove it and Lock it

To keep your tractors and GPS screensafe:

Remove screen when not in use and ensure they are left in a safe and secure location

Mark your postcode on GPS screen using forensic marking and use the stickers provided to advertise forensic marking is in use or, use and engraving tool

Record serial numbers and take photographs/videos from several angles, including any identifying marks

Use PIN's – activate PIN security on GPS kit with your own unique number if possible
